

2020-2021 BUDGET OVERVIEW AS OF DECEMBER 2020

Dear Parishioners,

Overall, I am very happy to report that, in spite of the challenges of the pandemic, we stand financially sound and good. I thank so much all who contribute to our parish financially; we cannot do everything alone, but uniting together our prayers, financial gifts, and talents, we are able to provide excellent services to one another and compassionate help to those in need locally and beyond our borders.

In December 2019, at the half way point of our fiscal year, we reached 50.25% budget income and 49.03% of budget expenses.

In December 2020 our income is 49.30% of budget and expenses are 44.92%. Considering the number of weeks the parish was closed due to COVID we are very fortunate our income was not much lower. Expenses are lower in some programs due to not meeting or no activity, but that increased expenses in other areas. We needed to make some substantial investments in the area of communication. Video equipment needed to be purchased for the church and for the John M. Phillips Parish Life Center in order to stream masses as well as updating equipment for our Religious Education. They became necessary since our Religious Education Programs are mostly now done online.

Once Masses began in person we needed to invest in a number of safety measures for our church for sanitation purposes. This also increased the number of times the church needed to be cleaned and disinfected. Though we received a lot of help from our dedicated volunteers we had to hire people to do the extra cleaning and sanitization. Our parishioners have been very faithful and generous during this time which has allowed our parish to be in a good financial position. I commend my staff for keeping ministry area budgets to a lower level.

I express my sincere gratitude to the Members of the Finance Council, Members of the staff, and my dear Parishioners of Holy Faith.






