Every Friday in Lent at 12 noon & 6 pm (Church)

Although it is a time to confront the pain and suffering of our lives and the world, for Christians, it is also a time to proclaim our belief in the Resurrection and rejoice in the victory of Jesus over death. FIRST FRIDAY HOLY HOUR & EXPOSITION:

Friday, Mar. 4 – 10:00am – 12noon & 7:00 – 8:30 pm (Church)

The Eucharist: the Most Holy Sacrament that we celebrate Sunday after Sunday, where we offer the good and the bad of our lives in a living sacrifice united with Jesus. This is the same Lord that we come to adore, available on the first Fridays in a special way, the celebration of the Church's Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. This is a celebration of the Church reaffirming the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass where our lives are transformed. As all the First Friday traditions at Holy Faith, we will gather on **April 5**, in the morning hours beginning at 10 am and later for a Holy Hour at 7:00 pm ending with Benediction (immediately following the Stations of the Cross.
