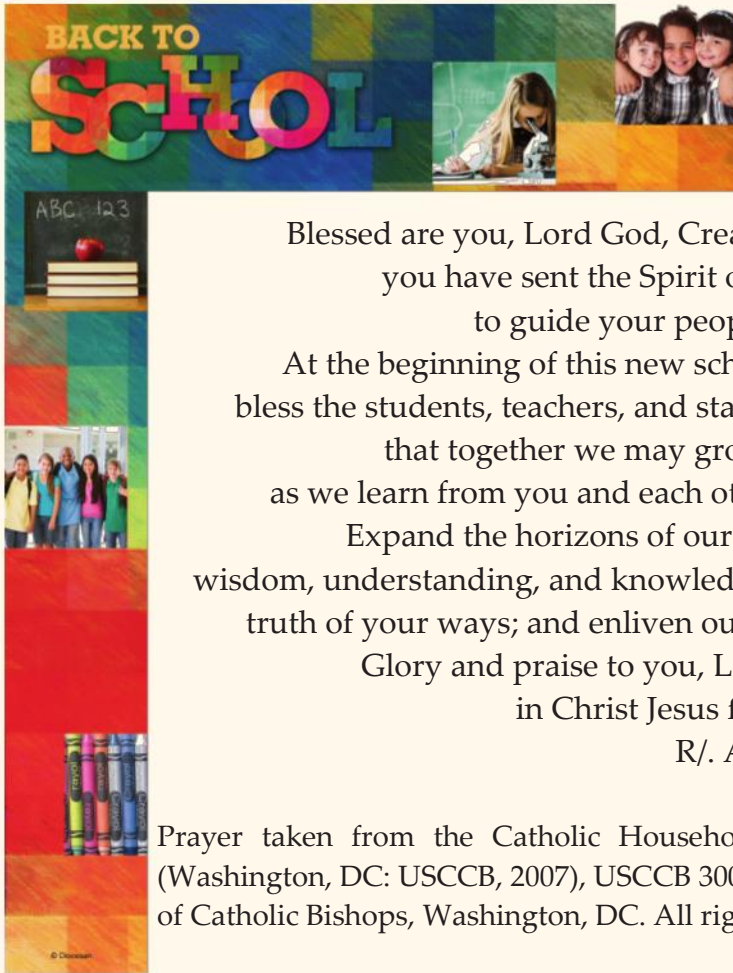

It has been a long time tradition at Holy Faith to support our Migrant brothers and sisters through the Fall Back-To-School Backpack Program. Year after year, parishioners would donate backpacks for all children, filled with school supplies so they would have what they needed to get a great start in the new school year, and the families are always most grateful.

This year the School Board is providing some basic school supplies and backpacks to the migrant families, so additional backpacks will not be needed.

So, in the spirit of giving to those in need, and in keeping with our vision of building together a community of compassion in Christ, we would like to continue our support of our migrant families in a different way this year.

Since many of the migrant workers have been out of work and unable to travel to their usual work locations, mostly due to covid and lack of available work, it would be very helpful and truly appreciated if **donations of Walmart gift cards** in any amount were donated, instead of the backpacks. This will help the families provide back-to-school clothing, shoes and food, which is what is needed most at this time.

White envelopes are provided in the vestibule of the church, with "Migrant Education" written on them to place the gift card donations. Please put your name on the envelope and place in the collection basket, to be distributed to the families through Migrant Education before school begins. Again, Thank you for your support and love for migrant families.
