

ON DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY AT HOLY FAITH

Join us for a brief video: "St. Faustina and Divine Mercy"

Today: April 16 at 1:00pm in the Church followed by the Divine Mercy Holy Hour which will begin at 2:15pm and end at 3:00pm.

We will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Adoration, Music, a brief Meditation, the Singing of the Divine Mercy Chaplet together, and end with Benediction and a small reception.

Today, on the Second Sunday of Easter, April 16, we celebrate *Divine Mercy Sunday*. Christ Jesus came to us with God's mercy in order to save us. *Mercy is God's love in action in response to our need*, especially to our world's miseries. Jesus as the pre-eternal Son of God became human and suffered for us on the Cross to show us the sacrificial love of God.

His Resurrection, which we celebrate intensely in this 50 day Easter Season, reveals to us that *this divine love never ends*.

Of course, Jesus *is* the mercy of God and we who are united to him, our Head, as his Body the Church, *must also be merciful*. With so much hatred and division in our world, *will we choose to ignore the misery of others or be the Lord's witnesses of mercy?*

JESUS, I TRUST IN THEE

'Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.' (cf. Lk 6:36)"

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us – all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy. The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

- *A Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.
- *B Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.
- *C Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received by our trust. The more we open the door of our hearts and lives to Him with trust, the more we can receive.

This message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God's mercy. Even before her death in 1938, the devotion to The Divine Mercy had begun to spread.

Following Jesus is our greatest adventure!




