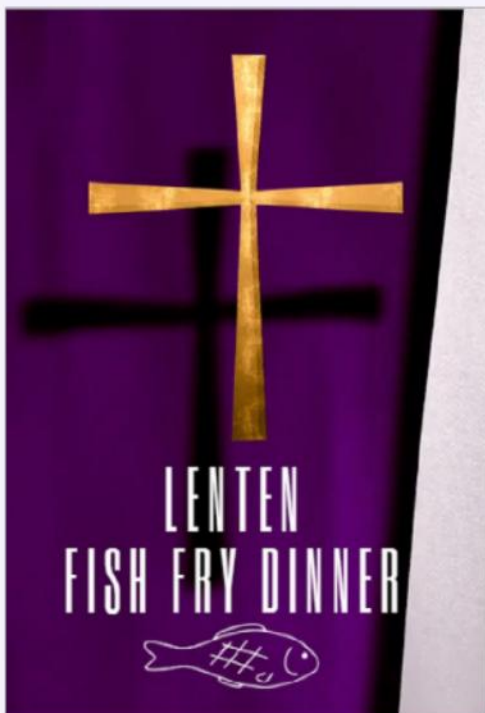

The Season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday. Mass times with imposition of Ashes: 7am; 9:30am and 7pm.

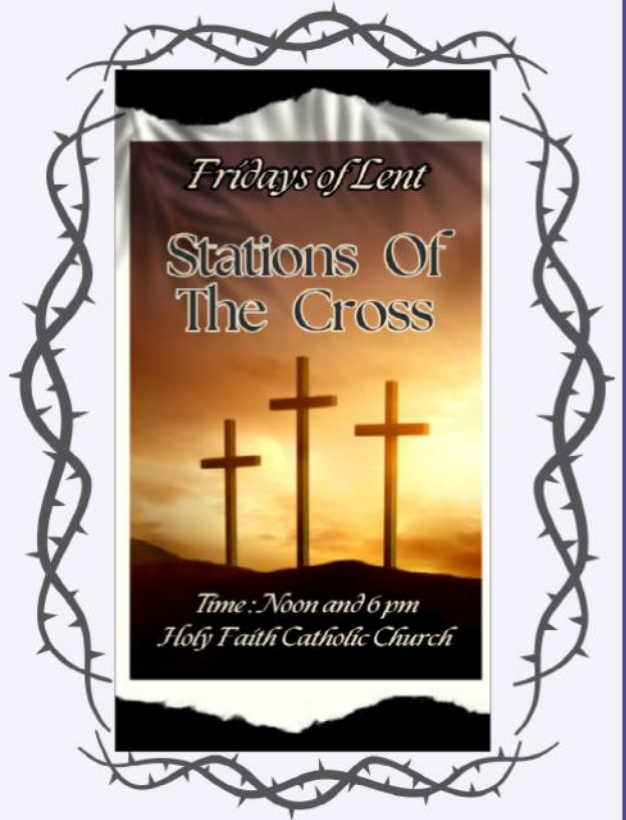
Reminder: Ash Wednesday is a Day of Fasting and Abstinence from meat.
