ON DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY AT HOLY FAITH



HOLY HOUR PRAYER SERVICE SUNDAY, APRIL 7 2024 ... 2:15PM

The Sunday after Easter, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday and it has been a tradition at Holy Faith to have a Holy Hour Prayer Service, with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Meditation and Reflection, and the singing of the Divine Mercy Chaplet followed by a small reception. We begin this devotion in the church at 2:15pm in song to the Divine Mercy.

Please join us in prayer as we turn to the Lord asking for His Divine Mercy with the words *"Jesus I trust in You"*.

Reminder: The 9-day Novena to the Divine Mercy began on Good Friday. There is still time to catch up and pray daily at the request of Jesus through St. Faustina.

To Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska, a simple, uneducated but courageous woman religious who trusted Jesus without limit, Our Lord consigned the great mission to proclaim the message of Divine Mercy directed to the whole world: "To-day", He told her, "I am sending you, with My mercy, to the people of the whole world. I do not want to punish aching mankind; but I desire to heal it, pressing it to my merciful heart". (Diary, 1588).

"You are the secretary of my mercy; I have chosen you for that office in this and the next life" (Diary, 1605) "to make known to souls the great mercy that I have for them, and to exhort them to trust in the bottomless depths of My mercy". (Diary 1567).

Before Blessed Pope St. John II was canonized a Saint, he established the feast of Divine Mercy at the canonization of Saint Faustina on April 30 in the year 2000, and the official decree from the Sacred Congregation of Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments came just days later on May 5, 2000. Blessed Pope John Paul II, at a dinner following the canonization of Saint Faustina and the surprise announcement of the establishment of Divine Mercy Sunday, had commented that it was 'the happiest day of his life'. And no wonder, for as he had stated previously, he had fulfilled the will of Christ by instituting the Feast of Divine Mercy.

*Not only did he establish this Feast of Divine Mercy, but by God's Providence, he died on the vigil of that feast, just five years later on April 2, 2005. His last written words, recorded from his deathbed, called for a greater acceptance and understanding of Divine Mercy. He had written these words to be read to the public on Divine Mercy Sunday, which were read on that very day, and ended with the words **"Jesus, I trust in You, have mercy on us and on the whole world"**.*

So let's celebrate with our Holy Father Pope Francis and the world, this feast of Divine Mercy next Sunday, April 7 together at Holy Faith at 2:15pm in the church. Come and Pray!

CCF NEWS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS


