

Please note that Sacramental Prep for First Sacraments begins with attendance in First Grade. Confirmation preparation begins with attendance in 8th grade. Also all parents, including Catholic School, homeschool or private school parents can register their 8th thru 12th grade students for Catholic Youth Ministry (CYM) on this same form. CYM meets on selected Sundays from 4pm to 5:30pm and offers the youth a safe place to grow and share in their faith with their peers, and includes service projects to aid in earning required service hours.

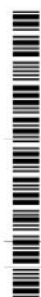
